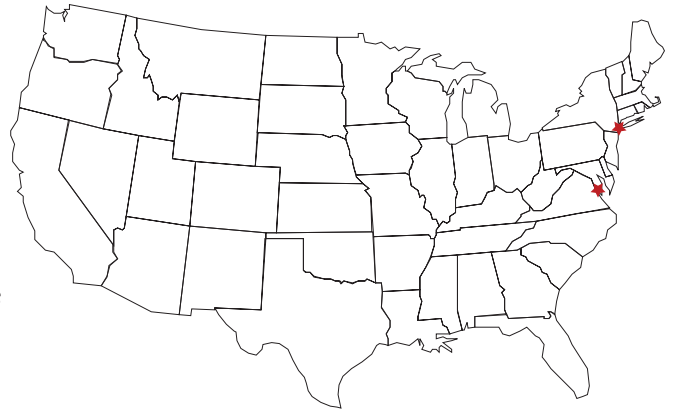




Seeing Stars
