

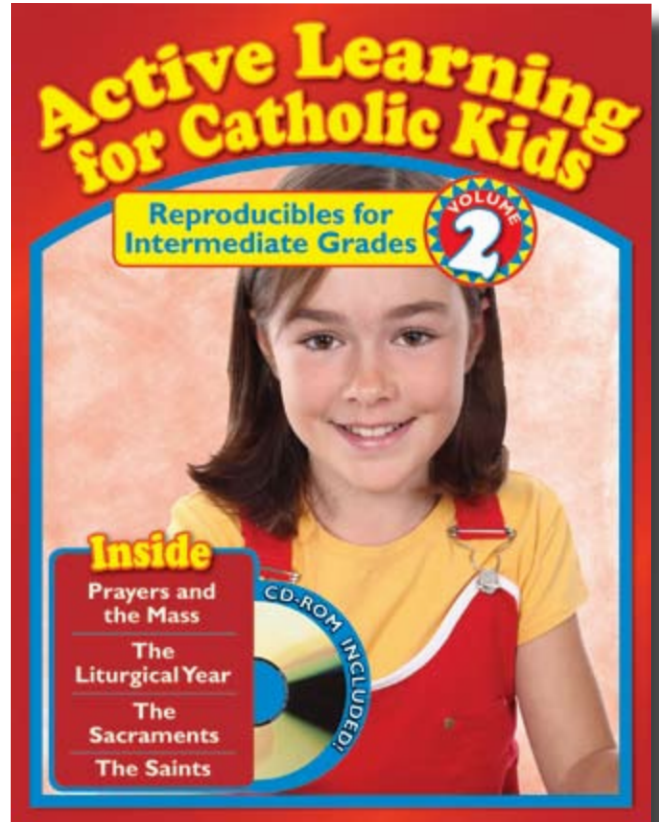

Special Dreams

All of us dream and some of us remember our dreams. Then we try to find meaning in them. Even when he was a child in the Italian city of Turin, St. John Bosco realized that his dreams were actually messages from God. They led him to his life's work, helping girls and boys who lived on city streets and were often mistreated. With his magic tricks, he gave the children rare moments of joy. And, by providing them with food, a place to live, and an education, he helped them live useful lives. The people who helped John Bosco were known as the Society of St. Francis de Sales, or Salesians. To this day, Salesians work to improve lives around the world.

St. John Bosco had a bag of magic and juggling tricks that he used to amuse the street children he went on to help. The square here is called a Magic Square. Try it at the same time as a friend and see who finishes first.

Using each only once, place the numbers 3 through 11 in the boxes. Any three numbers in a row—across, down, or diagonally, must add up to 21. We've placed the number 7 to get you started.
