



# Family Corner

### **FAITH FOCUS**

It's a challenge to keep the family focused on the true meaning of Christmas. Trees, tinsel, trains, and toys are hard to compete with!

During Advent, you may have participated in an outreach program to help needy families enjoy a few gifts and a nice holiday meal. Try to remain involved in these activities year round. Show your children that Christmas is the birth, or "beginning," of a year of helping others, as Jesus did throughout his life.

### **FAMILY ACTIVITY**

On Christmas, before the gifts are opened, set aside an empty box. Ask each family member to save a piece of wrapping paper from one gift.
