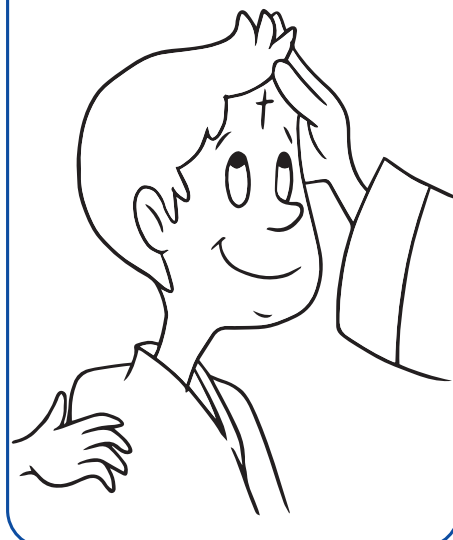


Instructions

- ◆ Briefly explain the three sacraments. On each one, the children highlight the symbol represented by each sacrament with a yellow marker (the water of Baptism, the Holy Oil of Confirmation, and the Host for Communion). The children then add another color to the sacraments that he or she has already received.
- ◆ Clap out the syllables of the Scripture verse based on Mark 16:15 below.

Give rhythm to the sentence.

- The dot represents a short sound or gesture, such as clapping your hands or tapping a table.
- The dash represents a long sound or gesture, such as sliding your hands against each other or on a table. The dash emphasizes the most important parts of the sentence.
