

Split up the children into groups of 4, providing one sheet per group. Have a volunteer cut out the 12 tiles, and make 3 stacks for each type of card. Then, have each child pick one of each type of card and read it aloud to the group.

Afterward, invite the children to choose a card that relates to their feelings about Mass and/or the Eucharist, and share with the group. them, and try to match them back up. There are multiple possible combinations.
